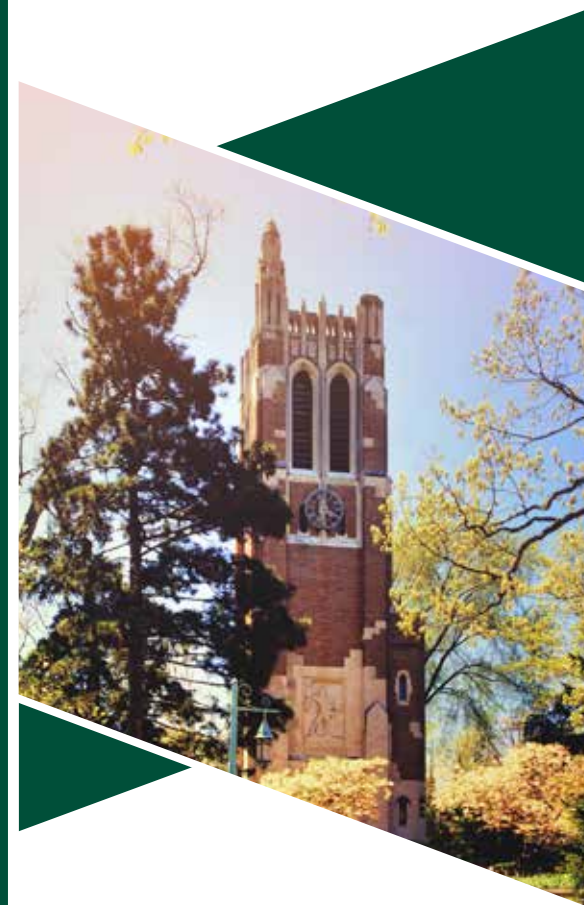

ENDOWMENT HISTORY

The MSU Alumni Club of the Muskegon Lakeshore Area Academic Scholarship was established in 2016 by the MSU Alumni Club of Muskegon County acting on their love for MSU and passion for helping students achieve their dreams for higher education. The scholarship was created in hopes of encouraging students who live in the Muskegon County area to attend Michigan State University.

Recipients are selected from a pool of students admitted to Michigan State University who are residents of Muskegon County, Michigan or are graduates of high schools located in Grand Haven, MI or Spring Lake, MI with an incoming GPA of 3.5. The awards are granted based on financial need, and are not limited by a student's intended major or field of study.

Contributions to the scholarship benefit students directly. Gifts to the fund are invested as principal, and the scholarship awards will be paid out of the annual interest earned by the investment. The scholarship program is run through the Office of Admissions. Awards from the endowment are distributed at the discretion of this office in collaboration with the MSU Alumni Club.
